Generation No. 1

1. Jean Baptiste Thomas¹ BORDELON, born about 1670, in Le Havre, Rouen, Normandie, France, died about 1732, in , , France. He married (1) Magdeleine DE BRACHON about 1692, in Le Havre, Seine-Maritime, Haute-Normandie, France. Magdeleine DE BRACHON was born before 1674, in Le Havre, Rouen, Normandie, France, died 1698, in , , France. He married (2) Madgdeleine DE CHAMPGAUTIERES RICHOUF about 1698, in Le Havre, Seine-Maritime, Haute-Normandie, France. Madgdeleine DE CHAMPGAUTIERES RICHOUF was born in Le Havre, Seine-Maritime, Haute-Normandie, France. He married (3) Henriette ROCHECHOUART about 1720, in Le Havre, Seine-Maritime, Haute-Normandie, France.

According to the book by Gremillion, the Jean Baptiste Bordelon family was the only Bordelon family at Le Havre for the period of 1578 - 1792. Jean Baptiste was the Supply/Comptroller for the French Navy.

Jean left his wife, Magdeleine De Richouf of Le Havre. She ssued him for separating of the assets of their community in 1719.

Jean Baptiste Thomas Bordelon was "contrôleur de vivre's de la marine" at the porte of Le Havre. The term "de vivre's" refers to supply, subsistence, and commissary functions of the Navy. It is evident that Jean Baptiste Bordelon Thomas father of Gabriel Laurent, later married to Magdeleine Richouf de Chapgautiers. Two children of this marriage were baptized at Notre Dame, La Havre, France. The archivist of the city of La Havre who searched the registries of Notre Dame Parish and Saint Françoise Parish, La Havre, stated that this family of Jean Baptiste Thomas Bordelon was the only Bordelon Family at La Havre for the period of 1578 - 1792.

1711 Jean Baptiste Thomas Bordelon was employed at the port of Rochefort, France as "directeur des vivre's do la marine" of that port from letters of the court the 1711 to 1712 in the archives of the Port of Rochefort, it appears that Bordelon had left his wife at Le Havre.

In 1719 Dame Magdeleine de Richouf, wife of Jean Baptiste Thomas Bordelon, successfully sued her husband for separation of the assets of their community.

Jean Baptiste Possible married a third time to Henriette Rochechouart. At the marriage of Gabriel Laurent to Anne Françoise Roland, Gabriel listed his parents as Jean Baptiste and Henriette Rochechouart.

Gabriel Laurent² BORDELON (*Jean Baptiste Thomas¹*), born 25 Oct 1696, in Le Havre, Seine-Maritime, Haute-Normandie, France, christened 26 Oct 1696, in Le Havre, Seine-Maritime, Haute-Normandie, France, died Feb 1737, in New Roads, Point Coupee, LA, USA. He married Anne Francoise ROLAND 20 Feb 1730, in New Orleans, Orleans, LA, USA. She was the daughter of Jean Baptiste Ambroise ROLAND and Jeanne BONNET. Anne Francoise ROLAND was born 1700, in St Germain, Paris, Ile-de-France, France, died 8 Jan 1758, in New Roads, Point Coupee, LA, USA, buried in Pointe Coupee, , LA, USA. Census: 1726, New Orleans, Orleans, LA, USA; 1745, Pointe Coupee, , LA, USA.

Although unconfirmed, it appears that Anne and Gabriel moved to Natchez shortly after their marriage where Anne gave birth to their son, Nicolas Bordelon.

Anne Francoise Roland, married (her 3rd) Jean Stephan called Roquancourt, a native of Basse Bretagne, France, at Pointe Coupee on February 1737.

Ann became rebellious in her teenage years possibly due to an overly strick father and jealous stepmother. By 1709, her father had lost all patience with his headstrong daughter and had no idea as to how to deal with her. He sent a petition to De Machault, the Chief of Police in Paris reporting her behavior. She was considered what would now call a "juvenile delinquent" and, as a result, was jailed in the infamous La Salpêtrière Prison in Paris and charged with debaucheries and public prostitution.

Thirza Vallois in a September 1998 issue of the Paris Kiosque writes that La Salpêtrière was originally a gunpowder factory set up in the 1600's to house "the tramps and vagabonds of Paris, it's rascals and rogues, whores and cut throats, charlatans and crooks - 40,000 in all out of a total population of 400,000!" Vallois quotes a royal edict dated 1656 that clearly states that the objective of La Salpêtrière was to "clear the streets of vice whilst providing shelter for this wretched portion of humanity" as well as "put an end to beggary and idleness, as being the source of all disorder".

Conditions at La Salpêtrière apparently deteriorated dramatically after 1680, when following a new royal edict, it became a jail for prostitutes arrested on the authority of a sealed letter from the King. Vallois writes: "Caught in the net on the streets of Paris, they were driven in carts through crowds of jeering Parisians to La Salpêtrière, where they were paired off with hardened convicts and shipped of to the New World to populate it's newly conquered territories".

Duc de la Rochefoucauld reported after a visit to La Salpêtrière: "Everything is in a state of neglect to a degree as inconceivable as it is distressing. All categories of madness are confounded. chained up mad women (and there are many of them) are united with peaceful ones. The latter have to put up permanently with the horrific spectacle of the contortions and fury of their enraged inmates, which they accompany with perpetual screams, and never enjoy a moment of rest... Here there is no gentleness, no

consolation, no remedy." Vallois goes on to state that Duc de La Rochefoucauld failed to mention that the building was overrun by voracious rats!

(Note: La Salpêtrière is now the largest hospital in Paris and is the hospital at which Princess Diana died.)

We can only assume that Anne was subject to deplorable conditions during her stay at La Salpêtrière so it is possible that she welcomed the forced deportation to the New World in June of 1719. At that time, she was deemed suitable to be sent to the islands and placed aboard the ship "La Mutine" by order of the King along with approximately 100 other women of "questionable character."

Ironically, the crimes for which Anne was charged would probably be considered very minor by today's standards. According to an article that appeared in the Imperial St. Landry Genealogical & Historical Society publication (Volume IV, #2) entitled "Anne Francoise Rolland", there "never was any concrete evidence in her file to show that the charge of prostitution was valid".

Occupation: He married (1) Marie Anne DECUIR 23 Apr 1759, in New Roads, Point Coupee, LA, USA. She was the daughter of Stephanus Josephus DECUIR and Cecile RONDOT. Marie Anne DECUIR was born 27 Nov 1740, in New Roads, Point Coupee, LA, USA, died 22 Dec 1778, in New Roads, Point Coupee, LA, USA. Antoine I was declared a Revolutionary Patriot by virtue of his service with Galvez at the time of the America Revolution

Of the 12 children of both marriages (Pierre, Marianne, Lucile, Augustin, Francois, Vallery and Zenon) can be placed at Avoyelles Post. Antoine II was at Natchitoches Post 26 January 1795 as a witness of the marriage of his cousin. Hypolite Bordelon, Victorie and Her husband George Baron were in Avoyelles later. Hilaire married Sophie Soileau and settled at Opelousas Post.

There record of Antoine at the Avoyelles Post May 1785 just months before his death. It was shown he owned 3 slaves, 50 Arpents of land, a home and a variety of farm animals. This was the most land owned of anyone else in this early census.

Antoine also served as warden of the parish church at Point Coupee Post.

Was member of the Police Jury after statehood of Louisiana of 1812.

It was Zenon that moved the family roots from Point Coupee to Avoyelles and started the root in Avoyelles. Most of Antoine's children had relocated to Avoyelles before his death.

Zenon has at least two sons that fought in the Civil War for the Confederacy.

The Avoyelles 1850 Census shows Eulalie as the widow Zenon Bordelon. Still at home was Norbert. Also living with her was the widow Valery Mayeux (her daughter Eulalie) and the grandchildren: Marceline, Privoz, Dorsin, Cleophine & Helena Mayeux. Eulalie was living between J. B. & Aimee Bonnette and Sylvert and Eliza Bordelon.

The 1860 Census shows Eulalie as a widow living alone. Living on one side was her son Louis F. Bordelon and his first wife Aimee. On the other side was his daughter, Eulalie, the widow Valery Mayeux and her children. Value of the real estate was \$3,500.

The 1860 Census shows this couple with 4 children at home: Joseph, Roselia, Marie & Ludger. They were living between Celestin & Irma Gauthier, and the widow Zenon Bordelon.

Louis and his mother owned a few slaves as seen on the 1860 Slave Schedule. Louis owned 1 (16 year old) female and his mother (widow Zenon Bordelon) owned 3 - age 25, 3 and 2.

The 1850 Census shows this couple living between the widow Elienne St Romain and Andrew & Elizabeth Amstrong. There were 6 children at home.

They Landed in New York in 1840, and the enterprising Frenchman set out to make his fortune in French Louisiana. He found it in the town of Marksville, center of the bayous, plains and lush farmlands of Avoyelles Parish, hard by the Red, Mississippi and Atchafalaya rivers.

Soon after arriving in Marksville Auguste Voinche began buying real estate and also went into the retail business. He soon became the leading merchant of the area. For years the Voinche store was the leading business in Marksville. It was an impressive, four story building facing the courthouse square. And Voinche also owned a good part of the real estate of downtown Marksville.

Though very wealthy, Auguste Voinche lost much of his property during the Civil War and Reconstruction. He owned, at the time St. Joseph Roman Church was built in 1869, most of the property on the street and donated the site for the church and convent.

During the Civil War bales of cotton were stored in the basement of the Voinche store to await higher prices, and legend has it that the lower floor was used to hide cotton during the invasion of federal troops. The Voinche building is still standing and has undergone extensive rebuilding and remodeling over the years. For more than a century, through the 1960's, Voinche descendants continued in the retail business, in various buildings, along this block facing the square. At the end of the 20th century the building needed expensive work and efforts were under way to restore the premises.

In early 1863, the hospital at Fort DeRussy was moved to Auguste Voinche's brick building in Marksville. This building is still in existence, across the street from the courthouse. In 1864, a large quantity of cotton was removed from the basement of the building and carried to the Union gunboats at Fort DeRussy. Voinche's attempt to obtain reimbursement for that cotton resulted in over 2,000 pages of testimony, providing us with much insight into events at the Fort during it's "Gunboat Station" period.
