Pierre Parent from Mortagne, Perche, France was born in 1610, the son of Adre Parent and Marie Goudray, Pierre is estimated to have arrived in Quebec no later then 1651. This is predicated on the law that required single men to serve three years to before receiving citizenship and that the arrival would have had to have been at least three years before his marriage.

Pierre was married in the home of Lord Gifford at Quebec on 8 Feb 1654 to Jeanne Badeau, daughter of Jacques and Ann Ardouin of Beauport. Pierre and Jeanne had seventeen children, thirteen sons and four daughters.

Pierre was a butcher by trade. Shortly after their marriage, they bought land to raise cattle to support the butcher trade. Subsequently a large quarry was developed on the property and much stone was quarried to supply the builders in Quebec City.

Jeanne Badeau arrived with her family, in New France in about 1648, her father agreeing to come on 12 Apr 1647 at La Rochelle, France.

On 5 Nov 1686 in absence of her husband, built a house on Rue de Sault o Matelot (French Canadian Ansesters Vol XIII p. 51)

Joseph was probably born in Nicolet, Quebec, Canada where his parents were married and where his grandparents were also married.

He was first identified in the records of the Baton Rouge Diocese when he married in 1843. Also identified in this Church record were the names of his parents and the town in Quebec from which he came.

LA. Land records showed in 1847 Joseph owned 174 Acres in West Baton Rouge.

He was again identified in the 1850 Census as living in the area covered by the post office located in Lobell's Store in West Baton Rouge Parish. During this period he attended St. John the Baptist in Bruly where the majority of his children were baptized and one daughter, Emelie, age 17 was buried on 20 Feb 1864.

The 1870 census identified Joseph as residing in the Port Hudson census area. Joseph was still alive in 1873, as recorded in the Baton Rouge Diocese records when he attended the wedding of his daughter Henriette Alexandrine to Lucien Francois Brousard, at Immaculate Conception, Canal. This was the last recorded mention of Joseph Parent.

Joseph's grandson Lee had stated to Larry Parent that he had gone to the funeral of one of his uncles and that Joseph had been buried there. The cemetery was in the area of Grenwell Springs and looked down on a river. I have been unable to locate that cemetery.

Later moved to Garyville where Mrs Parent operated a boarding house. Finally move to Livingston with Mrs Parent having boarding house and Mr Parent had laundry, soda fountain, theatre etc.

Harry William Parent lived with his parents near Lakeland, LA. on a cotton plantation. When he was about seven, in about 1890 the crops were wiped out by weevils so his father, Henry, moved the family to New Roads.

At the age of ten or eleven he and brother Alphonse would wash bottles and fill them. With fourmular, he and his brothers delivered soda pop to stores around the island. This normally took all day and occasionally they had to spend the night away from home. Harry and his brothers learned to swim in the Mississippi River. Their mother would tie a rope around their waist and they could swim the length of the rope.

After moving to Garyville, Mr Parent went to high school. Because of tutoring he was too advanced for his class and left high school to enter Baton Rouge Business College which he completed in 1912 at the age of 18.

Harry William Parent, Army Serial No. 1609622, served as a sergeant of Company A. Development Battalion, Camp Beuregard, LA, United States Army. He served from 29 May, 1918 until 9 Mar 1919.

Belle Parker lived with her family when in approximate 1906 they moved from Brewton, Escambia, AL. to Leakesville, Greene, MS. At the time her father was in logging. In approx 1915 they moved to Moss Point and bought a restaurant. Later in 1919 they moved to Pascagoula where they lived in a house on Telephone Road, next to the Baptist Church. Belle returned to Mobile with her sister where they were employed by George Pressenos in his restaurants. Her sister Lene would marry George. In the meantime her parents had accepted a position in the delta region of Mississippi, to run a boarding house for a lumber camp. She was asked to come as they needed her help. Lene went with her on the train and while riding they took notice of a young man sitting across the aisle. Upon arrival the superintendent of the logging camp was waiting for them and apparently, the young man they had been discussing on the train. As they got into the car he was introduced to them as Mr. Harry Parent. Life in the lumber camp was rather simple and Belle saw a lot of Harry. In fact Harry often helped out in the kitchen, something he learned at his mother's boarding house. Soon Harry asked Belle to marry him, much to the displeasure of her mother. At this Belle returned to Mobile to stay with Lene and her husband George, but additional plans had been made. She took a train to Vicksburg, MS where she met

Harry. He had Agreement with a friend, and they were married in the Catholic Church at Vicksburg, MS.

Belle Parent was living Tempary at 5275 11th St. (at the residence of Florence Parent & Ralph Bordelon) Katy, TX, where she died between 2 & 5:30. She died in her sleep and her head was resting in her left hand as if just resting. She had a glass of tea a little before 2 p.m.. Florence Parent and Ralph Bordelon and Paul Parent were at the house when she died.
